Gardens by the Bay (Free Outdoor Areas)

 *Access via Bayfront Station (Exit B)*

Fort Canning Park — Colonial Echoes in the City

The park also holds historical significance as a site associated with Malay royalty, with some sources suggesting that it is believed to be the resting place of ancient Malay kings.
